Longest Night Service

For many the seasons of Advent and Christmas are often filled with expressions of joy, excitement, and happiness. It's a time for family to gather and for churches to worship pointing to the hope that is found in the coming of the Christ child. However, this time of joy and expectation can often overshadow the pain and hurt many experience during this season, when the world's merriment puts their grief and sorrow in stark relief.

The Service of the Longest Night is scheduled around the winter solstice (the longest night of the calendar year). We will light candles on the Advent Wreath, sing Advent hymns, pray together, and celebrate Holy Communion.
