The Tour Choir has perviously performed around the world in the UK, Germany, China, and at the White House. Pastor Jennifer is an alumni of Lycoming College and the Tour Choir. The choir has 10 male and 15 female students.

They will be arriving Saturday afternoon to rehearse in our sanctuary and we will be responsible for feeding them dinner. They will give a concert at 7pm and then go to host homes for the night. They will return on Sunday to share with us in worship.

**Safe Sanctuary Compliance needed
for Junior Church and Lighthouse Youth Group**

The Staff Pastoral-Parish Relations Committee (SPPRC) is requesting volunteers from the women of our church to chaperone Junior Church on Sundays 10:00am – 11:00am and the Lighthouse group on Thursday evenings 6:30pm - 8:00pm. Safe Sanctuary Policy requires two adults over the age of 18 and at least 5 years older than the oldest youth in the group. Our Youth Director, Joe Neri is leading these groups of both male and female youth and we judge a women is needed as the second adult. We currently have temporary solutions for this policy requirement but need to put in place a permanent solution.

The requirement would be eight adult women per month. All volunteers would need a background check. This check requires filling out 2 forms you can get from the wall file outside the office on the 2nd floor, or from our Office Manager Pat Van Vleck. You must also familiarize yourself with the Safe Sanctuary Policy. This policy is also available in the hall file or you can request the policy from Pat.

If we all pull together the impact on each of us is very small. If we can't comply with Safe Sanctuary the impact is huge as we will have to shut down our Junior Church and the Lighthouse group.

To get started we will be sending out two separate Sign-Up Genius requests for March. One for Junior Church and One for Lighthouse.

We pray the Holy Spirit finds you generous, so we can continue the spiritual nurturing of our youth.
