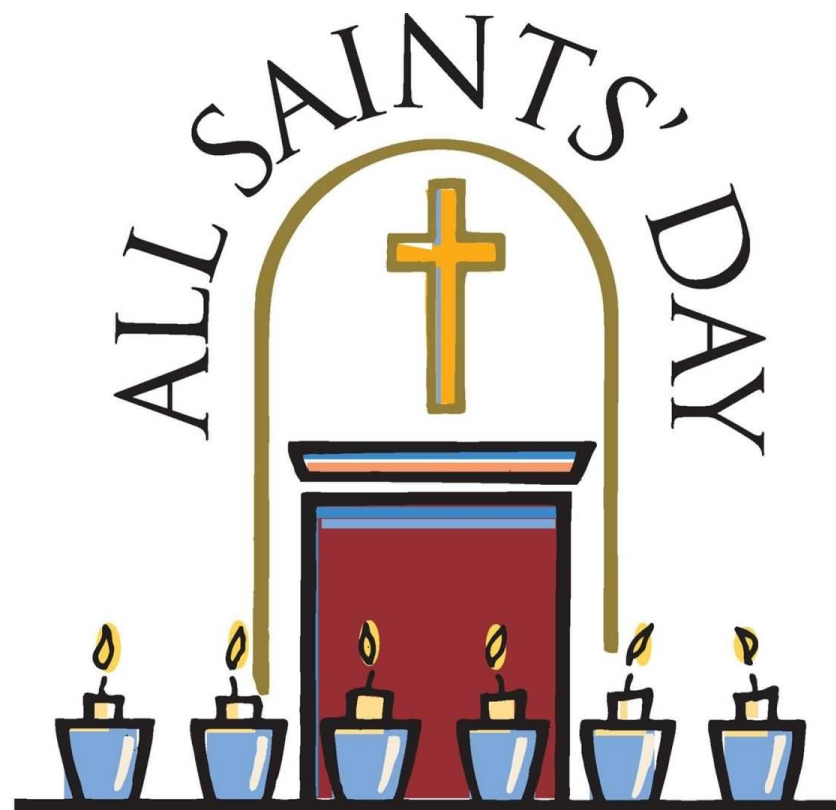

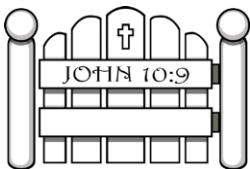
Sharing Suppers - November 11, 2017
