## Conflict in the Church: Entrusted with the Message of Reconciliation

This workshop is required for ALL Church leaders and is recommended for all active participants in the life of Hilton United Methodist Church.

Conflict is very much a part of our current society. Conflict is inevitable in our interpersonal relationships. As the people of God, it is imperative that we learn how to handle conflict in a healthy manner. This workshop will give us the tools necessary to approach conflict in a healthy manner.

The training will use biblical accounts, personal assessments and role playing to help transform each individual's understanding of conflict and the part it plays in congregational life. Attendees will be provided with tools to manage one's self in the midst of conflict and to lead churches through the process of creative group problem solving.

This training is going to be taught by Rev. Wilson Jones, an ordained Elder in the Upper New York Conference of the United Methodist Church. He received his M.Div from Asbury Theological Seminary and Doctor of Ministry from Drew University.
