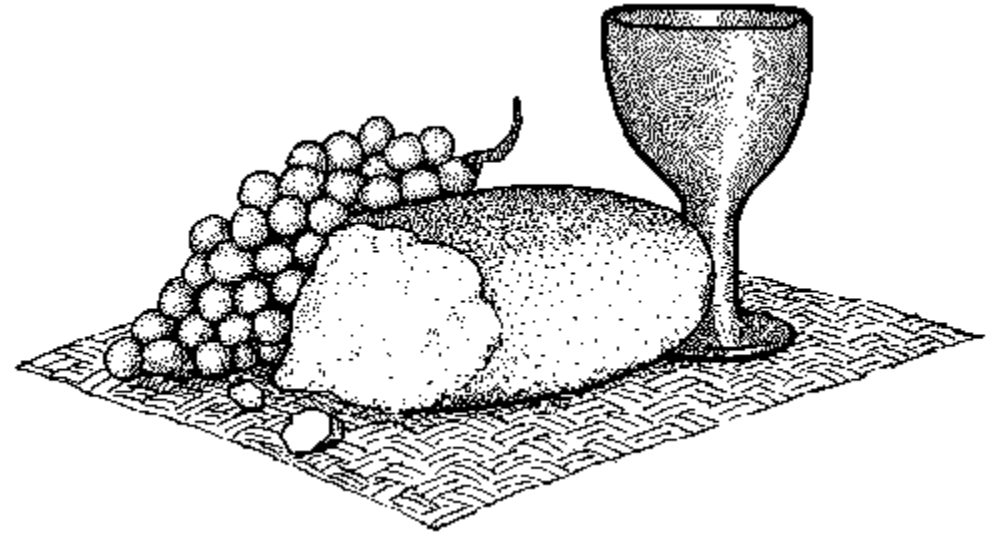
We stock the food pantries,

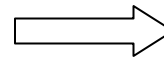
