We collected school supplies at VBS all week. We will continue to collect donations until Sunday, August 13th. Donation containers will be available at the church entrance.

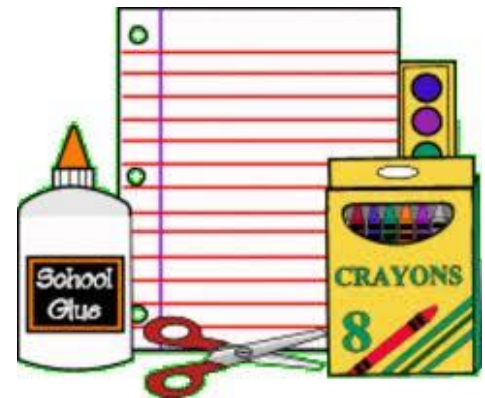

TREASURERS' REPORT Special Summer (July 2018)

As of July 1, 2018, we have the following balances in our major financial accounts:

Account Definitions:

Checking Accounts Account utilized to pay all internal and external invoices using Quicken.

Savings – General Account where all 2018 full year Offerings are held until released each month.

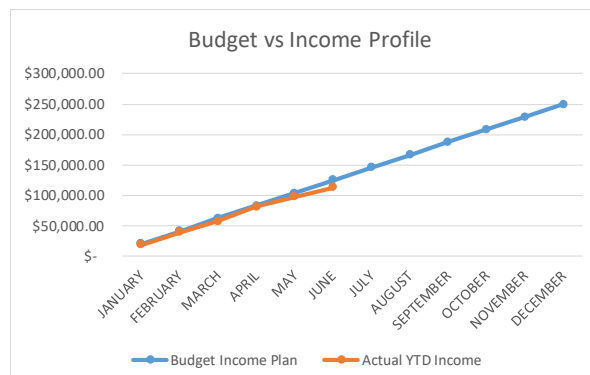
SUMMARY:

As of July 1, 2018,we have \$ 607.92 in the Checking account (in Quicken as shown above). It was necessary to move an additional \$3320.00 from the “Savings – General” account to cover the monthly expenses. All outstanding invoices have been paid as well as all salaries have been paid for June. June Ministry Shares of \$2,495.00 were not able to be paid due to cash flow, hopefully they will be able to be paid in the first week of July.

Key Financial Key points tracked;

- ✚ 2018 Ministry Shares, Health premiums and Retiree premiums are paid in year to date, with the exception of the June Ministry Shares. All Repeating expenses and Church Mutual Insurance were paid in full ... Year to Date.
- ✚ Our total Annualized income for June was \$15,401.12 with expenses of \$21,725.68, creating a short fall of \$6324.56; therefore, mandating moving funds from Savings to the Checking account to cover expenses. The YTD Annualized offering is \$11,690.05 below our annualized Year To Date (YTD) budget. June Monthly income was \$5,432.21 below our Monthly targeted income.

Communications:

❖ Our Church is doing more for the members as well as the community than ever before, our monthly expenses are actually running below our approved budget; but our income is short of our needs. We hope our collections will increase over the summer and would like your help in determining what we can do to increase our cash flow over the summer months. The summer is a very active time for our Church.

❖ **CONTRUCTION UNDERWAY:** If you have not had an opportunity to view the Church’s second floor (offices and Conference room) take a moment to stop by the second floor and see the changes being implemented by the Trustees!! It will provide a Large Comfortable Conference Room, a Private Professional Pastor’s Office and an Inviting Efficient Church Office. The majority of the cost to accomplish this much needed renovation is being provided by a couple of Church Members. But any contributions that you would like to make to support this Much Needed project for your Church would be VERY much appreciated and welcomed.

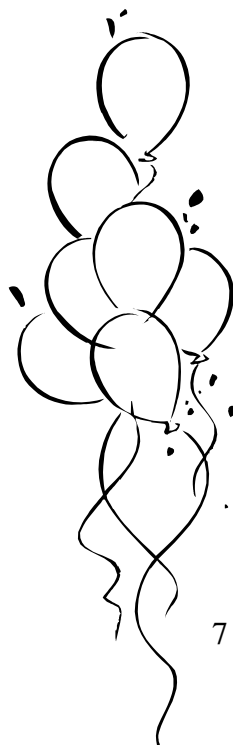
