Crop Walk Thanks You!

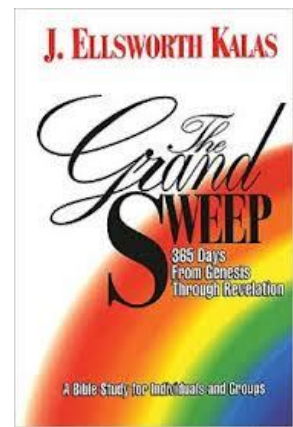

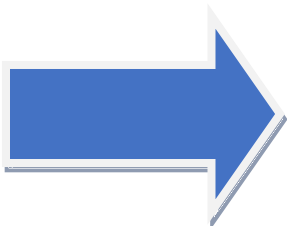

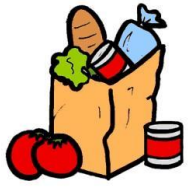

Cadet Cupboard – Local Mission Opportunity

The Missions Team of HUMC is coordinating an outreach 'be the church' to local families in need. The Summer Cadet Program's goal is to provide weekly supplementary boxes of food to Hilton's at-risk families. These families have been identified by Guidance Counselors at Hilton School District Elementary & Middle Schools. The children identified have been receiving food in their backpacks during the school year. The need is great through the summer months & HUMC is responding to this need.

The projected cost of each box is \$10 with donated produce. The time frame will be 10 weeks beginning the last day of school June 25th through Labor Day serving approx. 35 families. We will be providing more information in the weeks to come. It is a large task but we as a church will be able to meet this challenge. We will be looking for persons to help with the tasks at hand; do shopping; pack boxes; man the pick up as well as food donations, & financial support. With all of your help we can 'be the church'!

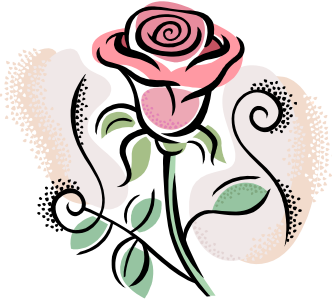
