

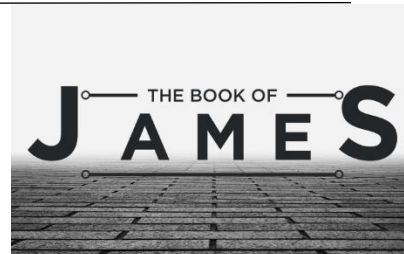

Healthy Conversations at HUMC

The United Methodist Church has hit an impasse on the question of human sexuality and gender identity. In the spirit of openness, we have decided to talk about it. In February of 2019 General Conference will receive the report and legislation on a Way Forward about whether or how to change our current connectional relationships. These relationships are something that many United Methodists pride themselves on.

Starting in September and continuing at least until the Conference in February, Pastor Jennifer will lead a Healthy Conversation Small Group. This group will be a safe place for people to learn, pray, be open to the Holy Spirit, and talk about human sexuality and gender identity. There may be some limited reading assigned throughout the conversations. Persons may choose to attend one or all of the conversations as they feel led.

Savings – General Account where all 2018 full year Offerings are held until released each month.

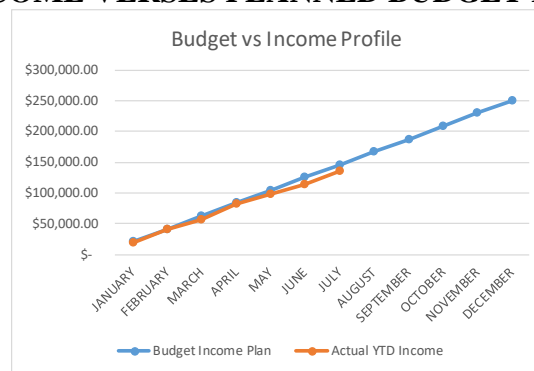
SUMMARY:

As of August 3, 2018we have \$ 142.70 in the Checking account (in Quicken as shown above). All outstanding invoices have been paid as well as all salaries have been paid for July. The July Ministry Shares of \$2,495.00 were not able to be paid due to cash flow, hopefully they will be able to paid in the first week of August.

Key Financial Key points tracked;

- ✚ 2018 Ministry Shares, Health premiums and Retiree premiums are paid in year to date, with the exception of the July Ministry Shares. All Repeating expenses and Church Mutual Insurance were paid in full ... Year to Date.
- ✚ Our total Annualized income for July was \$21,479.55 with expenses of \$21,00.45. The YTD Annualized offering is \$11,043.83 below our annualized Year To Date (YTD) budget. July Monthly income was \$642.22 above our Monthly targeted income – driven by a 5 week month.

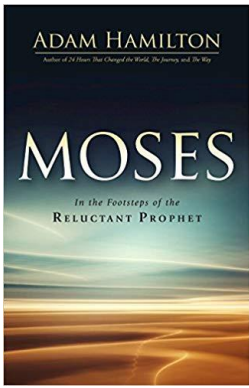
TOTAL ANNUALIZED INCOME VERSES PLANNED BUDGET PROFILE – MAY 2018
